1. GRADUATE INTERNS-TECHNICAL

Reporting to Heads of Divisions, the main purpose of the placement is to provide standardisation activities to UNBS stakeholders and will be responsible for the following duties;

- Develop, implement and enforce National Standards as guided by UNBS Act, regulations and procedures
- Provide technical and scientific input in the planning and operations of UNBS standardization programmes
- Undertake stakeholder analysis and incorporate requirements in the work programme in consultation with the supervisor
- Prepare and submit monthly, quarterly and annual reports
- Carry out any other duties as may be assigned by the supervisor or management.

Qualifications and other requirements

- Honours Degree in Chemistry, Biology, Food science, Food Technology, Engineering or any other science related qualification from a recognized University/Institution
- Must be computer literate with skills in MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Internet applications.
- Age: Between 22 and 30 years.

2. GRADUATE INTERN-NON TECHNICAL

Reporting to the Head of Division in area of deployment; the successful candidate shall be required to perform the following duties;

- Participate in the implementation of the programs as approved in the annual work plan.
- Perform any other duties as allocated by the supervisor.
- Prepare and submit monthly, quarterly and annual reports
